

YVCKC Summer Sensation 2010 Rules

Instructions

- T-Shirts (*Mon/Wed: blue shirt, Tues/Thurs: white shirt*)
- Bring water, sunscreen & bug spray for outdoor projects
- Close-toed shoes for every project—some will not let you serve without them.
- Appropriate clothes that can get dirty and/or permanently damaged (painting, staining, etc.)
- Bring lunch everyday (*except for KCCK, St. Mary's, Fairmount, Sanctuary of Hope, Joshua Center*)
- Some agencies provide lunch on Thursday; your Team Leader will let you know early that week.
- Leave your valuables at home.
- Keep an open mind and have fun!

YVC Rules

- Keep a positive attitude on projects.
- Respect fellow volunteers, Team Leaders and agency staff/clients on projects.
- Participate in any mandatory orientations, training, activities, reflections and evaluations.
- Be on time to projects.
- Work all scheduled project hours or notify YVC in advance if you cannot.
- Never use profanity, drugs, tobacco or alcohol on projects.
- Never engage in any sexual activity on projects.
- Be a team player during projects, working with others to meet goals and resolve conflicts.
- Not use personal electronic devices of any kind (MP3, games, cell phones).

Failure to follow the rules or instructions given to you while on a project will result in one of the following depending on the incident*:

1. You will be pulled aside and given a warning by a Team Leader.
2. Your parent/guardian will be called and asked how s/he would like the issue to be addressed.
3. You will be sent home for the remainder of the day/week.

*Behavior that warrants immediate dismissal includes the use of drugs or alcohol; serious harassment, including sexual harassment, of others; any sexual activity; purposeful violence against any person or animal; willful destruction of another's property; and theft.

Special Agency Rules

- Independence Animal: long pants, no jewelry, closed Monday
- Joshua Center: bring appropriate bathing suit and towel
- JVS and Hillcrest: may have different locations — Jessica will contact you, they will not be far
- Parkville Nature Sanctuary: long pants
- KCCK: long pants
- Sanctuary of Hope: work/hiking boots, long sleeve shirts recommended
- St. Mary's: fishing on the second day (bring poles if you have them)
- Turnstyles: please wear khaki pants/khaki knee-length shorts if possible
